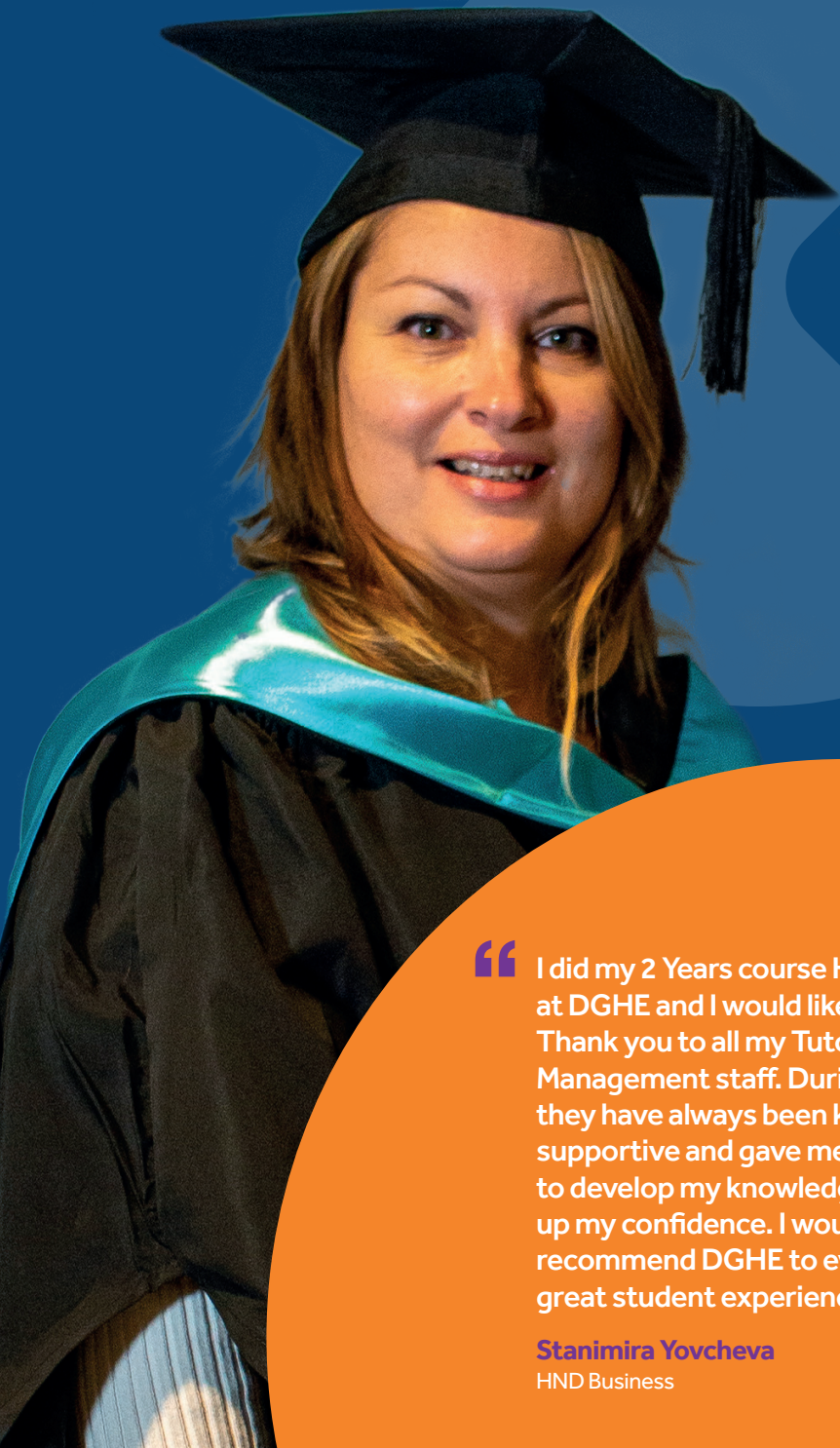
Study Skills Support

Course Entry Requirements (3 year programme)

The university considers a wide range of qualifications for entry. A typical offer would be 80-104 UCAS tariff points from:

- A minimum of two full A-levels (or equivalent)
- International Baccalaureate
- BTEC National Diploma
- Diplomas and Access courses
- Age 18 or above

English Language Requirements

Any student who has studied in a non-majority English speaking country will typically need to have achieved an IELTS score of 6.0 overall with no less than 5.5 in any band (or equivalent).

If you do not meet the minimum requirements for the three-year undergraduate programme, or don't feel fully prepared for a degree course, you can apply for a four-year programme including a Foundation Year in Business Management.

The BA (Hons) Business Management degree programme is delivered in partnership with Buckinghamshire New University. Study Options

This undergraduate degree is offered as a full-time study programme for 3 years as standard, or a 4 years study option including a foundation year. The Foundation Year programme aims to deliver relevant and comprehensive education providing you with a grounding in theory and a great deal of emphasis on the practical side of studying business. If you successfully complete the foundation year with the required grades, you can then progress on to your degree in Business Management.

Teaching & Learning

Our academic team have extensive industry and academic experience that enhances the delivery of the course. Lecturers will help students to obtain the necessary knowledge and skills to be positioned competitively when heading into employment.

Assessments Methods

The assessment strategy is designed to ensure that learning outcomes are achieved and that there is a development of knowledge and skills. Independent learning is embedded within the programme and students develop a depth of understanding via synthesis, critical analysis and evaluation. You will typically have one or two assessment points per module that are formally assessed. These range from individual coursework to group work and examinations. In your last year of study, you will develop and present a dissertation project based on original research collected and analysed by you.

Career Prospects

You will be well qualified to advance to a wide range of career opportunities in general management or to start your own company if you complete the programme successfully. You would have acquired a strong scope of knowledge and skills, allowing you to work in any field or business position, including operations and service management, customer management, project management or retail management.



Applying directly to the college

STEP 1 – Go to

www.dghe.ac.uk/apply and select the course you wish to apply for.

STEP 2 – Upload Documents

Documents to submit:

- Qualification certificates/transcript
- Original Passport and; or Residence Permit
- National ID card
- Updated CV
- Proof of Address
(Bank Statement, household utility bill, current UK driving licence)
- Personal Statement
- Passport Photo
- Settled Status Confirmation (if applicable)
- Portfolio (if applicable)

STEP 3 – Internal English Test

If you do not have the necessary English language qualification, you will be required to sit and pass the College's internal test.

STEP 4 – Arrange an Interview

Students will also be asked to attend an academic interview. Suitability for entry to our programmes can be demonstrated in several ways and is not limited to academic qualifications alone.

Applicants who do not meet our published entry requirements are encouraged to contact the admissions office for further advice.

STEP 5 – Accepting your Offer
