

Cancellation Notice

Contract for educational services

If your contract with David Game HE or University Centre at David Game College (the College) was formed entirely by means of distance communication (i.e. by post or electronic communication) without a face to face meeting with a member of the College staff you may cancel the contract within 14 days of the date of acceptance. The place was accepted when you returned the acceptance form and fulfilled the conditions set out in your offer letter.

You have the right to cancel the contract without giving any reason.

To exercise your right to cancel, you must inform us at the College's address of your decision to cancel this contract by a clear statement (e.g. a letter sent by post or an email). You may use the attached model cancellation form, or your own wording, if you prefer.

To meet the cancellation deadline you must send your communication concerning your exercise of the right to cancel before the cancellation period has expired.
